

PROTEST RIGHTS CARD

■ YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- Assemble peacefully (1st Amendment)
- Record police/public officials in public
- Remain silent – don't answer questions
- Refuse searches without consent

■ YOU DON'T HAVE TO:

- Unlock your phone or give your passcode
- Delete footage
- ID yourself (unless legally required)

■ PHONE TIPS:

- REMOVE Face/Fingerprint unlock — use code only
- Lock screen before filming
- Auto-backup footage if possible
- State date/time/location while recording

■ IF DETAINED, SAY:

"Am I free to go?"

"I'm exercising my right to remain silent. I want a lawyer."

■ QUICK PREP:

- Wear ID, carry cash
- Write emergency contact on your arm
- Don't protest alone
